Deuteronomy 31:8

Introduction:

1. Deuteronomy 31:8 is a message of encouragement from Moses to Joshua and the Israelites as they prepare to enter the Promised Land. It directly follows the announcement that Moses will not cross the Jordan with them, positioning Joshua as the new leader.
2. When the LORD goes before us, He empowers us, He is near to us, and He remembers us!
