Ken's Pen . . . 

A Father's Day Reflection

Father's Day is annually observed during the month of June, but the inspiration and influence of "fatherhood" is experienced worldwide every single day. For us sons and daughters, it is worthwhile to think for a moment or two about what this means to us.

The father of Scripture had supreme rights over his children. He had the authority to dispose of his daughter in marriage (Gen. 29) and to arrange his son's marriage (Gen. 24). He had the power of life and death, as in the case of Isaac (Gen. 22) and Jephthah's daughter (Jud. 11:34ff). Respect, reverence and affection for fathers (and equally for mothers) is most tenderly, explicitly and sternly prescribed from the earliest times (Exo. 20:12; Lev. 19:3; Deu. 5:16; Mic. 7:6; Eze. 22:7, etc.).

A balanced and beautiful picture of the duties and character of the ideal human father may be built up from the Old Testament, with added and enlarged touches from the New Testament: He loves (Gen. 37:4); commands (Gen. 50:16; Pro. 6:20); instructs (Pro. 1:8, etc.); guides, encourages, warns (Jer. 3:4; 1 Ths. 2:11); trains (Hos. 11:3); rebukes (Gen. 34:30); restrains (Eli, by contrast, 1 Sam. 3:13); punishes (Deu. 21:18); chastens (Pro. 3:12; Deu. 8:5); nourishes (Isa. 1:2); delights in his son (Pro. 3:12), and in his son's wisdom (Pro. 10:1); is deeply pained by his foolishness (Pro. 17:25); he is considerate of his children's needs and requests (Mat. 7:10); considerate of their burdens, or sins (Mal. 3:17); considerably self-restrained (Eph. 6:4); having in view their highest ends; pitiful (Psa. 103:13); and the last human friend to ever think of deserting the child (Psa. 27:10).

Many there are who, as they remember the fathers who gave their lives support, have a Father's Day every day. They remember an unceasing love that is the earthly shadow from a heavenly source.

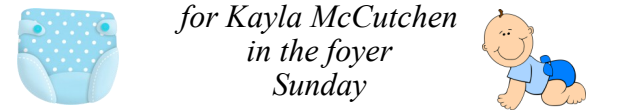
